What You Need to Know About the Dextromethorphan Sales Restriction



To help prevent teens from abusing over-the-counter (OTC) cough medicine containing the active ingredient dextromethorphan (DXM), Oregon law (effective as of January 1, 2018) prohibits the sale of these medicines to minors.

HOW DO I KNOW IF A PRODUCT CONTAINS DXM?

- · Check the Drug Facts label for the active ingredient DXM
- · Check the packaging for the Stop Medicine Abuse icon
